Article I. DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Section 1.01 NAME OF THE ORGANIZATION

a. The title of this corporation shall be Plainview Civic Music Association. (PCMA)

Section 1.02 SEAL AND LOGO OF THE ORGANIZATION

- a. The Board of Directors shall provide a corporate seal, which shall be in the form of a circle and shall have inscribed thereon the name of the corporation and the words "Corporate Seal of Plainview Civic Music Association, Inc."
- (i) The corporate seal is to be centered on Plainview Civic Music Association letterhead and on any official business communication representing the board's official operations.
- b. The Board of Directors shall provide a logo, which shall have a treble clef with staff lines ascending and descending in a wave-like fashion. The letter in bold and capitalized reading, "PCMA". The aforementioned text fitting within the margins set by the text above official name of the organization "Plainview Civic Music Association. Lastly, underneath the aforementioned text shall reside the "tag phrase" of the Association which reads "Our Community Our Talent"
- (i) The logo is to be centered on Plainview Civic Music Association promotional materials advertising Plainview Civic Music Association sponsored events, including posters flyers and pamphlets, leaflets and other forms of advertising media.
- c. The Board of directors shall maintain a webpage which shall contain appropriate graphics in varying formats of the Seal and Logo which may freely be used by any ensemble director for promotional means as necessary. No other logo seals or graphics may be used in official PCMA without consent of the board of the directors.

Section 1.03 MISSION

- a. The Plainview Civic Music Association, Inc., consist up of a variety of musical ensembles including:

- (i) The Plainview Civic Music Association Guild
- c. These entities are a vital to the cultural life of this agricultural area by
- (i) providing affordable, yet influential
 - quality musical experiences.
- d. In addition to encouraging
- (i) music appreciation and
- (ii) concert etiquette,
- e. PCMA provides a platform for gifted citizens (young and old) to,
- (i) showcase their talent
- f. while engaging in
- (i) community service and
- (ii) cultural enrichment
- g. Additional musical ensemble medium(s) may be created and sponsored at the discretion of the board.
- h. The namesake and logo, if desired, of any ensemble under the oversight of the Plainview Civic Music Association though originated and proposed by the new ensemble's director, must be approved by the board.
- i. The official unadulterated mission statement shall read as follows:

The Plainview Civic Music Association, Inc. consists of a variety of musical ensembles in tandem with The Plainview Civic Music Association Guild. These entities are vital to the community as they contribute to the quality of life in this agricultural region by providing affordable, yet influential musical experiences. In addition to encouraging music appreciation and concert etiquette, PCMA provides a platform for gifted citizens, young and old, to showcase their talents while engaging in community service and cultural enrichment.
